This event is ideal for first time and move-up competitors as well as green horses. We have also updated our old divisions and added some new challenging divisions. Courses are rolling to hilly with banks, ditches, woods and water for Beg. Novice and up. Green Novice is a do-able full-length course with an optional bank. Walk Trot is truly a ground pole course, no ditches, banks or water. Stadium has 10-12 colorful jumps with walls, brush and flowers. We welcome questions on rules and the courses anytime before or during the show. We want to see each horse and rider succeed as well as be challenged. **See more detailed info at applewoodeventing.com.**

RULES AND PRIZE LISTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Ribbons awarded for places 1 - 8 in each C/T (Combined Test), HT (Horse Trial) division/split
Equine merchandise awarded for 1st place in each CT and HT division/splits.

Divisions in all shows may be further split by either horse/rider experience or by age of rider. A place will not be held if entries are not complete (**SIGNED ENTRY FORM, ENTRY FEE, COPY OF NEG COGGINS TEST w/in 12 calendar months**) and **RECEIVED BY THE CLOSE DATE**. Entries post-marked on the close date may not be accepted (but would be returned in full). No refunds of accepted entries after close date. Only one copy of current coggins test is required per show season. Friday schooling fee applies to all, including those renting stalls. Stalls are limited, so complete reservation on entry form and mail early. **No telephone reservations will be taken.**

USEA and AHSA rules governing Combined Tests, Horse Trials and Jumper Classes apply as much as possible. Judges and show committee decisions are final.

Bit and Equipment rules are strictly enforced. Pony Club members competing in Walk-Trot Division only of CT and HT may use **Pony Club approved bits** in all Walk-Trot phases. Only bits allowed in AHSA Rules for Combined Training/Eventing will be permitted in all other divisions at CT and HT's. Appropriate show attire is recommended.

ASTM APPROVED HEADGEAR (with chin straps fastened) MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED. PROTECTIVE VEST IS REQUIRED FOR CROSS COUNTRY. No Exceptions.

We welcome riders and horses of all experience levels. Because we do have a number of very green horses and riders at every show, **safety rules are strictly enforced on the entire grounds. (AHSA Rules for CT/Eventing, Article 1715.3.)**

Part of the function of Stadium Phase at our show is to demonstrate a readiness for that level of Cross Country. No stadium jump is more difficult than obstacles on the X-C Phase. Negotiating turns and riding the terrain in Stadium demonstrates controllability and balance that is required for that level on X-C. **Those eliminated in Stadium will not be allowed to continue HC in X-C.** (permission may be granted to school with a trainer after the show) **In addition to the rules above, the following actions are cause for elimination at any of our shows:**

Excessive speed and or lack of directional control

Several near falls of horse or rider

Failure to maintain contact/excessively long reins on course

Jumping warm-up jumps in wrong direction (they are flagged)

Failure to obey any direction given by any show official (includes jump judges)

Cross-country and Stadium schooling will be available, by appointment, weather and turf conditions permitting, 7 days a week including the Friday before a show. Schooling Fee is \$20.00 per horse/rider, \$15.00 for Pony Club and 4-H members. A copy, for our file, of current neg. Coggins test, dated within one year, is required for schooling as well as shows. **Tack and concessions are available. Outdoor shows, held rain or shine.**
